

Thyssengas GmbH Price Sheet for Shippers and Downstream Network Operators Applicable from 1 January 2015

Published contracts and other documents are legally binding exclusively in the German language version. Translated contracts and documents such as this price sheet serve informational purposes only. Price sheet applicable from 01.01.2015

This Price Sheet is an essential part of the General Terms and Conditions of Entry and Exit Contract (Entry-Exit-System) of Thyssengas dated 01.08.2014 for Transports as of 01.10.2014 (in the following "EAV") as well as an essential part of the internal order according to Sections 11 ff. of the Cooperation Agreement between Operators of Gas Networks in Germany as amended on 30.06.2014 (in the following "KoV VII").

The network tariffs are also shown in the information assistant under www.thyssengas.com (Network enquiries service/Transparency information/Information assistant).

1. Network Tariffs for Firm and Interruptible Capacities

1.1 Daily Network Tariffs

The daily network tariffs in €/(kWh/h)/d to be paid for all entry and exit points as well as for backhaul transport are set out in the following table:

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Once Thyssengas offers within-day capacity products, the network tariffs for within-day capacity products equal to the respective daily network tariffs.

The booking period is from the beginning up to the end of the provision of the booked or ordered capacity by Thyssengas.

1.2 Network Tariffs for Firm Capacities

The network tariff to be paid by shippers or downstream network operators for firm capacities is calculated as the product of the booked or ordered entry or exit capacity in kWh/h and the daily network tariff in €/(kWh/h)/d at the entry or exit point concerned or for backhaul transports and the number of gas days for the respective booking period.

1.3 Network Tariffs for Interruptible Capacities

The network tariff for interruptible entry capacities at cross-border interconnection points and market area interconnection points amounts to 90 % of the network tariff valid at the respective entry point for firm capacities according to Section 1.2. of this price sheet.

The network tariff for interruptible entry capacities at storages and for interruptible exit capacities at storages, to end-consumers and to downstream network operators amounts to 60% of the network tariff applicable at the respective entry or exit point for firm capacities according to Section 1.2.

The network tariff for interruptible backhaul capacities amounts to 60% of the network tariff applicable for firm backhaul capacities according to Section 1.2. of this price sheet.

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2. Contract Penalty

The contract penalty according to Section 30 para. 4 EAV in conjunction with Section 10 of the Supplementary Terms and Conditions of Thyssengas dated 01.08.2014 for exceeding the booked capacity for each day with exceeded capacity as well as according to Section 18 para. 7 KoV VII for exceeding the ordered capacity for each day with exceeded capacity is determined as the product of the highest hourly exceeding capacity on day the excess occurs and 4 times the network tariff for the respective entry or exit point or for backhaul transport according to Section 1.1 of this price sheet.

3. Prices for Settlement of Excess / Shortfall Quantities

The monthly average settlement energy price applicable for settlement of excess / shortfall quantities for SLP and RLM customers according to Section 24 para. 3 and 4 EAV is published on the internet under www.net-connect-germany.de (Excess/Shortfall quantity price SLP / Excess/Shortfall quantity price RDM).

4. Biogas Levy

The biogas levy according to Section 25 para. 1 EAV as well as Section 7 KoV VII amounts to 0.00164915 €/(kWh/h)/d.

The biogas levy is raised at exit points to connected end-consumers and downstream network operators, respectively.

5. Levy for Market Region Changeover

The levy for market region changeover ("Marktraumumstellungsumlage") according to Section 25 para. 1 EAV as well as Section 10 KoV VII amounts to 0.00001101 €/(kWh/h)/d.

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The levy for market region changeover is raised at all exit points as well as for backhaul transports.

6. Tariffs for Meter Operation, Meter Reading and Billing

The tariffs for meter operation, meter reading and billing are as follows:
